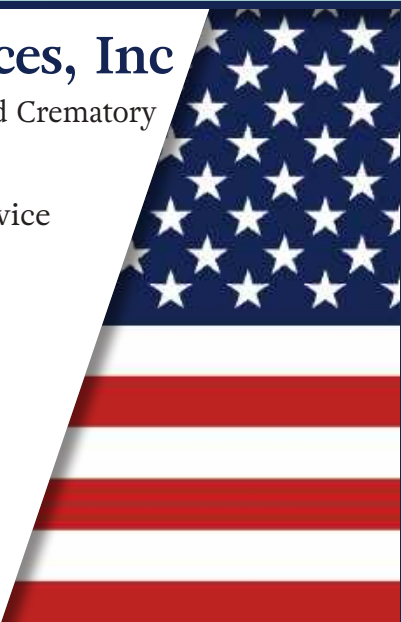

NO-BAKE KEY LIME PIE

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pre-made graham cracker crust
- 1 can sweetened condensed milk (14 oz)
- 1/2 cup key lime juice
- 1 block cream cheese (8 oz, softened)
- Whipped cream for topping



DIRECTIONS

1. In a mixing bowl, beat the cream cheese until smooth.
2. Add the sweetened condensed milk and blend until silky.
3. Mix in the key lime juice — the filling will thicken as it sits.
4. Pour into the graham cracker crust and smooth the top.
5. Chill in the refrigerator for at least 3–4 hours, or overnight for best firmness.
6. Top with whipped cream before serving.
