### ***Lunch at Ben Wilson Senior Center***

Everyone loves lunch for \$2.00, however the County pays \$5.59 per lunch. So, when you order lunch but do not come in to eat it, the numbers are reflected in the money and the count that is sent to the County. When the Center count is off too often, AAA can look up who has been ordering lunches, and they can see if you order and do or do not come in for lunch. If this happens too often, we get questioned by the county about why our numbers are not accurate. If the same person continues to order lunches but continues not to come in for lunch, we may be asked not to take their lunch reservations.

The people that continue to not make a reservation but want lunch can also be a problem. We do put people on the wait list, but we are not guaranteed to have enough food for all of those people. We will always try to find food for everyone, but we cannot guarantee what it will be.

We just ask that you please pay close attention to your lunch schedule.

## Watermelon Mint Cooler (Non-Alcoholic)

### Ingredients

- \*watermelon chunks (about 3 cups)
- \*fresh mint leaves (about 6–8)
- \*lime juice (1 to 2 tablespoons)
- \*cold water or sparkling water (1 cup)
- \*ice
- optional: a little honey or simple syrup if you want it sweeter*
- garnish with extra mint if you like*

5. pour over ice
