Easy Summer Peach Crisp



Ingredients

- 4 cups fresh peaches, sliced
- 1/3 cup granulated sugar
- 1 tsp lemon juice
- 1 cup granola or crisp-style cereal
- 2 tbsp melted butter
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 350°F.
2. Toss sliced peaches with sugar and lemon juice; spread in a small baking dish.
3. Mix granola, melted butter, and cinnamon until lightly coated.
4. Sprinkle the granola mixture evenly over the peaches.
5. Bake 25–30 minutes until the topping is golden and the peaches are bubbling.
6. Serve warm — vanilla ice cream or whipped cream makes it extra summery.
